This Week in Leas Foot

As mathematicians this week, Year 2 have moved onto a new unit of learning focusing on addition and subtraction. They have started by focusing on related addition and subtraction facts called fact families. They have also recognised that addition is commutative and subtraction is not.

Meanwhile the Year 1s have been wowing ourselves with our brilliance in Number Sense each day! It is so wonderful to hear how much the children LOVE their mathematical learning! We have also spent some more time consolidating our numbers to 10 by comparing them and using *greater than* and *less than*.

As historians, we have been thinking about our direct family links and how historians show this. The children created a mini family tree to show themselves, siblings, parents and grandparents.

As artists, we spent time developing our colour mixing knowledge further with a focus on creating tints and tones of a primary colour. We learned that when you add white to a colour you create a tint, and when you add black to a colour you create a tone.

As global citizens in RE this week, we have explored the importance of Allah's name to Muslims by learning about the Shahadah and the adhan. We created our own calligraphy representations of Allah's name in Arabic and learnt about the tradition of whispering the adhan in a newborn baby's ear.
